General Function:

Responsibilities:

- Work with Head Coach to design, develop and implement synchronized swimming curriculum to prepare intermediate participants for performance and competition.
- Attend clinics and competitions as required. Overnight and air travel may be required.
- Work with Head Coach and help to communicate program information with parents and program participants.
- Assure cleanliness of the program area and surfaces, as well as proper water chemistry and report repair/maintenance needs .
- Assist Head Coach to develop and implement strategies to increase program participants and assist with special events to attract new participants, while supporting existing program participants.
- Greet members and participants, creating a welcoming atmosphere while enforcing the policies and rules of the area.
- As needed, assist participants with setting personal goals, plan incentive programs.
- Attend meetings and perform other duties as requested.
